**FOREWORD**

---

The Calendar of Technical Assistance for Co-operatives has now been published for a number of years. During this time it has been possible with the help of many organisations to collect more information about technical assistance programmes for co-operatives in the developing countries. The part co-operatives play in the social and economic development of the Third World is increasingly recognised by the United Nations, and also by other inter-governmental and non-governmental agencies.

Many more projects of technical assistance to co-operatives are undertaken than could possibly be listed in the Calendar. Several co-operative organisations in developed countries provide "in-country" training courses for co-operators in the developing countries and others provide financial aid raised from voluntary contributions for international educational activities. Some of the auxiliary committees of the International Co-operative Alliance, such as the Co-operative Insurance Federation, through its Insurance Development Bureau, the International Committee of Workers' Co-operative Productive and Artisanal Societies through the Centre for the Promotion of Industrial Co-operatives in Warsaw (Poland) and the International Co-operative Housing Committee through the International Co-operative Housing Development Association (ICHDA) are providing advice and expertise on the promotion of co-operatives in the developing countries.

The Joint Committee for the Promotion of Aid to Co-operatives (COPAC), publishes a bulletin in English and French three times a year (February, June and October) listing co-operative projects in developing countries under consideration, and also co-operative projects which have recently been approved. The ICA is a member of COPAC along with the UN, ILO, FAO the International Federation of Agricultural Producers (IFAP), the International Federation of Plantation, Agricultural and Allied Workers (IFPAAW) and the World Council of Credit Unions (WOCCU).

The International Co-operative Alliance is grateful to all those individuals and organisations which have collaborated in providing the information published in the Calendar which, we believe, makes a useful contribution towards better co-ordinated information on technical assistance projects.

Any suggestions which would add to the usefulness of the Calendar would be most welcome.
