F o r e w o r d

The Calendar of Technical Assistance for Cooperatives has now been published for a number of years. During this time it has been possible with the help of the many organisations concerned, to progressively collect more information about technical assistance programmes for cooperatives in the developing countries. The part cooperatives play in the social and economic development of the Third World is increasingly recognised by the United Nations, other inter-governmental agencies and many non-governmental organisations.

Many more projects of technical assistance to cooperatives are undertaken than could possibly be listed in the Calendar. Several cooperative organisations in developed countries provide "in-country" training courses for cooperators in the developing countries and others provide financial aid raised from voluntary contributions for international educational activities. Some of the auxiliary committees of the International Cooperative Alliance, such as the Cooperative Insurance Federation, through its Insurance Development Bureau and the International Committee of Workers' Cooperative Productive and Artisanal Societies through the Centre for the Promotion of Industrial Cooperatives are providing advice and expertise in the promotion of cooperatives in the developing countries.

This year the information received from many and varied sources has been arranged in a different way. We hope that listing educational schemes according to the organisations providing them, instead of listing them in date order, will simplify and clarify the information.

The International Cooperative Alliance is grateful to all those individuals and organisations which have collaborated in providing the information published in the Calendar which, we believe, makes a useful contribution towards better coordinated information on technical assistance projects.

Any suggestions which would add to the usefulness of the Calendar would be most welcome.
