International Co-operative AllianceForeword

This "Calendar of Technical Assistance for Co-operatives" has been published annually by the International Co-operative Alliance since 1966. Its purpose is to provide as comprehensive a source of information as possible about schemes of technical assistance available during the current year for the benefit of cooperatives in developing countries.

It is based upon information supplied to the International Co-operative Alliance by a considerable variety of organisations engaged in such work. The Alliance is most grateful to its correspondents for the help they have given in the compilation of the Calendar. In some cases other useful information has been sent which the Alliance will be able to use in its other publications. This applies particularly to projects of a capital nature and to major schemes, such as those sponsored by the IBRD and IDA, which include a cooperative element within a much broader development project.

The Calendar is proving to be useful in two ways. It is a guide to cooperative organisations in developing countries about the facilities that are available to them. It also enables donor organisations to plan their technical assistance projects in the light of knowledge of what others are doing, thus avoiding overlapping and gaps. The Calendar is thus one of the instruments through which the ICA seeks to contribute to greater coordination of technical assistance for cooperatives in developing countries. We invite recipients to help us improve the effectiveness of the Calendar by sending us any additional information which could usefully be included in the next issue in 1973. Additional information about activities during 1972 will be published in the bulletin "Co-operative News Service" which is a valuable means of keeping the Calendar up to date throughout the year.

Notes

- (1) The Calendar is in two parts. Part I (pages 3 to 34) gives details of seminars and conferences planned for 1972 in chronological order. Part II (pages 35 to 67) gives details of new and continuing projects of a cooperative character which will be taking place in 1972. Details are given alphabetically by recipient countries. Enquiries on any specific projects listed in the Calendar should be directed to the sponsoring organisation concerned. The ICA would appreciate to be notified of any contacts.
- (2) Some courses at a number of Institutions are a continuation of courses from previous years. These are marked with an asterisk.
- (3) It should be borne in mind that a number of cooperative colleges and institutions accept students for courses which are primarily designed for personnel of the national movements concerned. These courses are too numerous to list in such a Calendar; therefore enquiries and applications for admission should be addressed direct to the national cooperative movement in question.
- (4) Technical Assistance by some countries takes the form of training personnel of their own cooperative movements for work in the developing countries as experts and advisers.
- (5) On pages 68 & 69 there is a list of the abbreviations used throughout the Calendar.
