Foreword

The Calendar of Technical Assistance for Cooperatives has now been published for a number of years. During the nine years of its existence, it has been possible to progressively collect from many organisations and agencies more information about cooperative seminars, training courses and other educational schemes as well as technical assistance projects in countries throughout the world. The part cooperatives can play in the social and economic development of the Third World is increasingly being recognised by governmental and non-governmental organisations.

Many more projects of technical assistance to cooperatives are undertaken than listed in the Calendar, but it would be impossible to mention them all. Mention may be made of several cooperative organisations that provide on-the-spot training of various length to cooperators from developing countries. The Cooperative Insurance Federation, through its Insurance Development Bureau, is providing advice and expertise in establishing cooperative insurance societies in developing countries. The Workers' Productive and Artisanal Societies Committee has recently set up a "Centre for the Promotion of Industrial Cooperatives" to promote activities to stimulate the development of industrial cooperatives giving priority to the needs of developing countries.

The International Cooperative Alliance is grateful to all those organisations which have collaborated in making it possible for us to publish the Calendar which, we believe, makes a useful contribution towards better coordinated information on technical assistance projects.

Any suggestions which would add to the usefulness of the Calendar would be most welcome.
