Foreword

This is the fifth issue of the annual "Calendar of Technical Assistance for Cooperatives", which has been published by the International Cooperative Alliance since 1966, in order to serve as a fairly comprehensive source of information on various schemes of technical assistance envisaged to be made available in various parts of the world, during the current year, for the benefit of cooperatives in developing countries.

Although the Calendar lists only the schemes and projects announced to the ICA by the end of January 1970, its contents should prove a reasonably helpful guide to all aid-seeking national cooperative organisations; at the same time, donor Organisations sponsoring various technical assistance projects (or intending to do so in future) should find its information useful for planning their activities in this field more effectively, with less risk of overlap.

Thus it is hoped, the Calendar will become one of the instruments through which the ICA seeks to contribute towards greater co-ordination in the field of technical assistance for cooperatives in developing countries.

Should any recipients of this Calendar know of additional information which could usefully be included, the ICA will be grateful for receiving details of any such projects.

All relevant information reaching the ICA during 1970 will be published in the bulletin "Cooperative News Service", through which efforts will be made to keep the Calendar up-to-date throughout the year.

Notes

- (1) The Calendar is in two parts. Part I gives details of seminars and conferences planned for 1970 in chronological order, as notified to the ICA. Part II gives details of new and continuing projects of a cooperative character which will be taking place in 1970. Details are given alphabetically by recipient countries.
- (2) Details of courses at a number of Institutions are not included where these are continuing from previous years without further recruitment, or where Institutions will receive students on request for appropriate courses.
- (3) It should be borne in mind that a number of countries accept students for courses in cooperative colleges and institutions where the courses are primarily designed for personnel of the national movement concerned. These courses are too numerous to list in such a Calendar and applications should be made to the national cooperative movement concerned, or the ICA, for further information.
- (4) Technical Assistance by some countries takes the form of training personnel of their own cooperative movements for work in the developing countries as experts and advisers.
