STATISTICS OF AFFILIATED ORGANISATIONS

INTRODUCTION

The International Co-operative Alliance presents its comparative statements for the years 1965 and 1966.

The data for 1966 cover Co-operatives in 58 of the 60 countries affiliated to the Alliance and have been compiled from replies received in answer to our questionnaires to member organisations; from national Annual Reports and published articles; and in some cases, from information received from correspondence with individual organisations. We are indebted to the Registrars of Co-operatives in Africa and Asia who have sent us annual reports relative to their countries; such statistics include all Co-operatives, whether or not the organisations are affiliated to the national Co-operative movement within the country.

For several years we have tried, unsuccessfully, to obtain information from the Ivory Coast and from Egypt. This year, we have omitted these countries from our statistical tables.

The general summaries for all types of Co-operative societies represent memberships and societies organised in:— Consumers; Agricultural and Forestry; Fishery; Workers' Productive and Artisanal; Building and Housing; and other types of co-operative activities. Insurance societies are not included in the general memberships total.

The memberships figure may, in some cases, include a duplication in that some persons are members of more than one society. To minimise double counting, wherever possible a Co-operative society which carries out multi-purpose activities, e.g. agricultural marketing and credit business, selling of consumer goods and farm supplies, etc, is recorded under the heading appropriate to the dominant activity of that organisation.

Total turnover statistics relate to Retail, Federated, and Wholesale Consumer societies; International trading organisations; Primary and Federal Agricultural and Forestry societies, Fishery societies; Workers' Productive and Artisanal societies and Miscellaneous societies.

Where no information has been obtained for 1966 the latest available data are given.

The source for the financial conversions from national currencies to Pound Sterling is the Financial Times. London.

TABLE 1 indicates the total number of members and the total number of societies within the countries affiliated to the Alliance. The memberships figure shows an increase of 3.43 % over 1965 - from 222,897,389 to 230,547,925. The number of societies has increased by 1.35 % over the same period - from 603,326 to 611,523.

TABLE 2 summarises the memberships and societies within the various types of societies. The percentage increase or decrease over the previous year is given together with the percentage distribution of each type of co-operative. The Consumer societies have slightly lessened their percentage share of the total memberships and the Agricultural societies have slightly increased their percentage share.

TABLE 3 outlines the trading activities of each section and gives the percentage increase or decrease over the previous year. No percentage figures are given for the Agricultural Primary and Federal societies since this is the first year we have attempted to separate the trading figures of the agricultural organisations.

TABLE 4 deals with the percentage comparison between total memberships and total turnover and for this purpose the memberships of the trading societies have been extracted from the overall memberships table. It is interesting to note how closely the percentage of total memberships compares with the percentage of total turnover.

TABLE 5 indicates the geographical distribution of memberships and societies of each type of co-operative and gives the percentage of memberships and societies within each continent.

General

Information not included in our statistical tables:-

In July 1967 the Organisation of the Co-operatives of America was accepted into membership of the Alliance. Its headquarters are in Puerto Rico. It has 90 societies in active membership and 33 collaborating members and the number of individual members included in these societies is estimated at 20 million. It operates in the American mainland and islands covering:-Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Canada, Columbia, Costa Rica, Chile, Ecquador, U.S.A., Honduras, Jamaica, Mexico, Panama, Peru, Puerto Rico, Dominiqan Republic, Uruguay and Venezuela.

Caisse Populaire Dominique Savio, Haiti, was accepted into membership of the Alliance in January 1968 and is a primary credit society with a membership of 290 persons.

TABLE 6 indicates the total turnover of the Co-operative Productive and Service societies. Such societies are reported from Consumer organisations in seven countries. The Belgian Coal Productive Federation is no longer in existence and has been deleted. The turnover figure of £122 million is an increase of 31.63 % over the previous year, due mainly to the inclusion of the Hungarian Productive and Service societies and the Federal Productive societies of Associazione Generale delle Cooperative Italiane.

TABLE 7 is a record of the total turnover of the two Scandinavian Wholesale societies and of the International Petroleum Association. The turnover figure of £31 million is a decrease of 1.12 % compared with 1965

TABLE 8 covers the total memberships and societies of all Consumer societies. The memberships figure shows an increase of 1.70 % over 1965 - from 110,019,429 to 111,896,273. The number of societies increased by 0.53 % - from 55,911 to 56,209.

48.53% of the total memberships of all affiliated organisations are in Consumer societies.

The total turnover of all Retail societies increased by 6.60 % over the previous year - from £19,180 million to £20,446 million. The Wholesale turnover increased over the same period by 1.65 % - from £7,123 million to £7,241 million.

Of the 19 countries listed, 10 show a reduction in the number of societies and an increase in both memberships and trade. In most cases, the reduction in the number of societies is the consequence of a continuing policy within European Consumer co-operatives of amalgamation and consolidation. The five countries with the largest increase in membership and turnover are:

Poland shows an increase of 1.79 % in memberships and 4.26 % in trade. Memberships in the U.S.S.R. increased by 2.05 % and the Retail trade increased by 8.27 %. The 1.965 turnover figure for the Provincial Unions of the U.S.S.R. is repeated as the 1.966 turnover figure for these Unions was omitted. From Italy only one organisation replied to cur

questionnaire, namely: Associazione Generale delle Cooperative Italiane. The data for Lega Nazionale delle Cooperative e Mutue were obtained by extracting figures from a report sent to our Publications Editor. The 1965 figures are again quoted for Confederazione Cooperative Italiana as no information was received for 1966.

AFRICA The decrease in memberships, societies and Retail turnover is due partly to the omission of Eastern Nigeria. No contact has been made with the Co-operative Union of Eastern Nigeria since Civil War broke out and Eastern Nigeria claimed independence as the State of Biafra. The reply received from the Registrar of Co-operative Societies of Western Nigeria included all memberships figures under Agricultural societies. The Wholesale trade of Western Nigeria increased by 19.39 % over the previous year. Uganda more than doubled its memberships and societies and its trade increased by 6.66 %.

AMERICA
The memberships of Argentina increased by 6.06 % but owing to currency alterations total turnover in £ sterling was slightly less than in 1965. In Argentinian pesos the increase in total turnover was 30.78 %. From Canada, Conseil Canadien de la Cooperative replied to our questionnaires but no reply was received from the Co-operative Union of Canada. The 1965 data are quoted for the latter. The number of societies in the U.S.A. decreased by 39.29 %, memberships increased by 9.93 % and Retail turnover increased by 6.85 %.

ASIA
The memberships figures for Cyprus show an increase of 4.73 % and Retail turnover increased by 10.35 % over the 1965 figures. The figures for India, from the Reserve Bank of India, show a 12.14 % increase in memberships. The rupee was devalued in June 1966 which accounts for the decline in the £ sterling figure for Retail turnover. In Rupees the increase in the Retail turnover was 42.48 % and the Wholesale turnover increased by 96.91 %. The information on Israel was obtained from a report of the I.C.A. Committee on Retail Distribution. Japan shows a 10 % increase in its memberships figures and a 25.74 % increase in its Retail turnover. Pakistan figures refer to West Pakistan only. We were pleased to receive up-to-date information of memberships and number of societies in Singapore as our previous figures refer to the year 1962.

OCEANIA The Co-operative Federation of Australia apologises for the inadequacy of its statistics but is hopeful of improving its records in future. For the first time we are recording information from the Federation of Native Associations of New Guinea and Papua. This organisation was accepted into membership of the Alliance in July 1967.

TABLE 9 is a record of the data received from countries whose national organisations were able to produce information relative to the number of male and female employees. The Co-operative Union of Great Britain did not separate males and females under 18 years of age; hence for the purpose of this table the total employees under 18 years of age of Great Britain has been equally divided into males and females. It is of interest to note the high percentage of females employed in Consumer societies within Europe.

The Agricultural co-operatives cover a wide range of undertakings such as: marketing; purchasing; supply; canning factories; milk processing plants; bacon factories etc.

The total memberships of all Agricultural and Forestry societies increased by 12.73 % over 1965 - from 32,776,628 to 36,951,430. The number of societies increased by 12.31 % over the same period - from 139,655 to 156,858.

16.03 % of the total memberships of all affiliated organisations are in Agricultural societies.

For the first time an attempt has been made to separate the total turnover figures into Primary societies and Federal societies but owing to the complexity of the agricultural structure this is not altogether

satisfactory. The combined turnover figures of Primary and Federal societies show a decrease of 12.47 % compared with 1965.

EUROPE The figures quoted for Czechoslovakia were extracted from a published article and refer to all J.Z.D. (agricultural) co-operatives. The local dairies in Sweden were included in the number of societies for 1965. These local dairies have been omitted from the 1966 figures, hence the large decrease Of the £34 million Primary turnover of VOLG of Switzerland, £14.5 million refers to Consumer goods, and of its £28.7 million Federal turnover, £3.4 million refers to home grown wheat.

AFRICA The data received from the Alliance of Ghana Co-operatives cover 49 Consumer shops, 694 Agricultural societies, 182 Fishery societies, 345 Workers' societies, 26 Transport societies, 77 Credit societies and 9 Butcher societies. More detailed information has been received from the Kenya National Federation of Co-operatives. The Primary total turnover figure of £30 million refers to the whole of the Co-operative movement in Kenya. The memberships and number of societies for Mauritius refer to the Tea societies only. To avoid double counting the membership figures of the Cane and Tobacco societies are classified under Credit societies. The total turnover figure for Mauritius however includes £1,403,000 for Cane and Tobacco societies and £17,000 for the Tea societies.

AMERICA The large increase in memberships and societies is due to the inclusion of information from Brazil and Jamaica. We were pleased to receive data from Jamaica as the previous figures received referred to the year 1959 and gave no indication of its Agricultural undertakings.

ASIA The figures relating to India were supplied by the Reserve Bank of India but are provisional figures only. The new information from Iran refers to the Central Organisation for Rural Co-operatives. This organisation was admitted into membership of the Alliance in 1967 and is an Agricultural/Credit co-operative. It loaned £11.5 million to its members in 1966. There is a Federal organisation comprising 2,509 societies and 52 Unions of societies which had a trade turnover in 1966 of £3.5 million.

OCEANIA The drop in memberships figures for Australia does not necessarily indicate a loss of members but can be attributed to a lack of information received by the Co-operative Federation of Australia from its member organisations.

The total memberships of all Fishery societies increased by 18.61 % over 1965 - from 1,248,720 to 1,481,154. The number of societies decreased by 15.70 % over the same period - from 10,263 to 8,652. The total turnover of trade increased by 55.19 % from £321 million in 1965 to £498 million in 1966.

EUROPE Although the memberships figures of Denmark and France show little alteration over the previous year, the total turnover figure for Denmark has increased by 9.09 % and the total turnover in France by 50.70 %. No such comparisons can be made for Italy as the most up-to-date information received from Lega Nazionale delle Cooperative e Mutue refers to the year 1961.

AFRICA The report submitted by the Registrar of Co-operative societies of Western Nigeria gave an inclusive figure of all agricultural activities and we assume that the fishery societies were included in this information and that in the past there has been a duplication of these figures. The exclusion of Western Nigeria from the table accounts for the large decrease in the African continent.

AMERICA The information received from Conseil Canadien indicated that although the memberships figure of the Federation des Pecheurs-Unis de Quebec remains static, the total turnover figure has increased by 76.60 % over the previous year. The 1965 data is again recorded for the Co-operative Union of Canada. We are pleased to have received data from Jamaica.

ASIA The provisional figures received from the "Reserve Bank of India show an increase in the Indian Fishery societies memberships of 6.61 % and a total turnover increase of 61.07 %. The Japanese societies continue to expand. Although the number of societies has decreased from 5,459 to 3,728, the memberships and total turnover are increasing rapidly. Over the past two years the memberships figures for Japan have increased from 627,259 to 981,636, and increase of 56.49 %. (The percentage increase over 1965 was 26.94 %). The total turnover increased from £260 million in 1965 to £432 million in 1966, an increase of 66.15 %.

The total memberships of all Workers' Productive and Artisanal societies show a decrease of 22.31 % since 1965 and the number of societies have decreased by 23.11 % over the same period. This is due mainly to the provisional figures received from India as these show a 32.13 % decrease in memberships and a 27.35 % decrease in the number of societies. The total turnover figure has increased from £1,451 million to £1,519 million, an increase of 4.65 %.

2.67 % of the total memberships of all affiliated organisations are in Workers' Productive and Artisanal societies.

The Workers' Productive and Artisanal societies within Europe cover a variety of trades and services including: clothing, footwear, printing, building, glass works, handicrafts, transport and cottage industries.

Although the number of societies has decreased in Denmark, the total turnover of these societies has increased by 2.30 % over 1965. The Confederation Generale des Societes Cooperatives Ouvrieres de Production of France has increased its memberships by 7.69 %, and its total turnover figure has increased from 900 million francs in 1965 to 1,200 million francs in 1966, an increase of 33.33 %. The memberships figure in Holland has increased by 45.60 % and the total turnover of trade by 18.32 %. Poland shows a 8.54 % increase in its memberships figure and a 15.61 % increase in its total turnover of trade.

AFRICA No statistics are available for Nigeria. The figures for Mauritius refer to the Printing and Transport societies.

AMERICA No new data have been received from the Co-operative Union of Canada or from Mexico, we are therefore publishing the figures as given last year.

ASIA Of the seven countries listed, one (India) sent us provisional figures and three did not return our questionnaire. The figures for Malaysia have been reclassified and included with the Agricultural societies. The Artisan and Handicraft societies of Jordan show an increase in memberships of 6.91 % over 1965 and an increase in the total turnover of trade of 31.91 % over the same period.

2.37 % of the total memberships of all affiliated organisations are in Building and Housing societies.

EUROPE Of the eleven countries listed, seven show increases in memberships and four show increases in the number of societies. The figures for Czechoslovakia were extracted from a report in "Czechoslovakian Co-operator" and cover all housing oo-operatives in Czechoslovakia. Although the "Haka" building societies of Finland do not produce membership figures, we are informed that of the 2,133 housing units constructed in 1966, 40 % are owned by the Housing societies and 60 % transferred to individuals. The memberships figures for Great Britain refer to the Co-operative Permanent Building

Society. There are a further nine societies affiliated to Co-operative Housing Associations for which no membership figures are given. The membership figures of C.P.B.S. increased by 9.14 % over the previous year. The two Housing organisations of Sweden show an overall percentange increase in membership figures of 6.87 % over the previous year. The memberships figure for H.S.B. increased by 7.10 % and that of Svenska Riksbyggen by 6.03 %. The units under construction for 1966 were:— H.S.B. 14,657 and Svenska Riksbyggen 9,044.

AFRICA Algeria shows a 3.88 % increase in its memberships figures and we are informed that of the 5,002 housing units constructed by the Housing association half are owned by the association and half are let to its members. The membership figures for Western Nigeria show an increase of 49.29 %. The Housing societies finance the buildings by way of making loans available to members at reasonable interest. Such loans are covered by the Co-operative Bank of Western Nigeria.

AMERICA The only new information available from the American continent was from La Federation des Cooperatives d'habitation of Canada. This Housing association indicated that in 1966, 198 units were constructed at a value of 2,100,000 C\$ (£695,000).

ASIA India continues to increase its memberships and number of societies. Jordan shows an increase of 10.78 % in its memberships figures and an 11.76 % increase in its number of societies.

The data from Malaysia refer to 61 housing societies, not all of whom are affiliated to the Federation of Cooperative Housing societies. The figures for 1965 are from the 13 societies affiliated to the Federation. The welcome information from Singapore is the first we have received since 1960.

OCEANIA The large increase is due to submission by Australia of more details of its housing societies. The Association of Co-operative Building Societies of New South Wales has a membership of 81,500 and constructed 5,600 housing units in 1966.

TABLE 14 covers the total memberships and number of societies of all Credit societies. The memberships figure has increased by 3.45 % over the previous year - from 62,480,582 to 64,641,660. The number of societies has increased by 1.53 % over the same period - from 291,655 to 296,138.

 $28.04\,\%$ of the total memberships of all affiliated organisations are in Credit societies.

Austria shows a slight decrease in the number of societies and a 6.02 % increase in its memberships. France still has the largest number of memberships and societies in Europe. The figures were extracted from a report issued by "Comite General de la Cooperation Agricoles des pays de la

communaute economique europeenne" and refer to the Agricultural Credit societies only. Hungary has a 19.25 % increase in its memberships figures and Roumanian memberhsips have increased by 7.25 %.

AFRICA The large decrease in memberships and societies in Africa is mainly due to the exclusion of Eastern Nigeria.

AMERICA Apart from Jamaica all other information on Credit societies was obtained from the International Credit Union Yearbook issued by Cuna International. The data from Jamaica was supplied by the Registrar of Co-operative societies.

ASIA For the first time since 1962 we have up-to-date information from the Turkish Central Bank of Cyprus. There are 193 Credit societies and savings banks within its organisation with a membership of 25,080. The Co-operative Central Bank of Cyprus has 441 Credit societies and Savings Banks within its organisation with a membership of 109,413. The combined increase of these two organisations over the 1965 memberships figure is 4.44 %. Unfortunately, the 1966 figures from India arrived too late for inclusion in this report; we have therefore quoted the 1965 figures. The data from Malaysia came from the Statistical Schedule issued by the Department of Co-operative Development, covering all Credit co-operative societies within the country. The 78 Credit societies of Singapore cover four types of co-operative Credit organisations, namely: Thrift and Loan societies, Employees Credit societies. Thrift and Investment societies and Rural Credit societies.

OCEANIA The large increase is because Australia was able to supply us with more information from its member organisations.

TABLE 15 is an analysis of some of the Balance Sheets of Credit societies. No comparable figures are given because a new questionnaire was drafted for 1966 making comparisions with the 1965 data impossible. The statistics for France cover the Fishery Credit societies only; no information was available for the Agricultural credit societies. The data from Italy refer only to the credit societies affiliated to Associazione Generale delle Co-operative Italiane.

These societies comprise a group of Co-operative organisations difficult to classify with other sections.

The total memberships of all Miscellaneous societies decreased by 3.03 % over the previous year - from 6,328,545 to 6,137,057. The number of societies decreased from 9,578 to 9,272, a 3.02 % decrease. The total turnover figure was 1.76 % less than a year ago. These decreases are mainly due to the exclusion of Egypt, Nigeria and Australia and to the reclassification of Brazil to the Agricultural section.

EUROPE The miscellaneous societies in Europe include the Chemist societies of Belgium whose turnover for 1966 was £14 million, five societies in Great Britain with a turnover in 1966 of £4 million and the Cultural, Recreation and Legal Aid societies of Italy.

AFRICA Information was unobtainable from Eygpt and Eastern Nigeria (Biafra) and the statistics submitted by the Registrar of Co-operative Societies of Western Nigeria gave no indication of any unclassified societies.

AMERICA The decrease in the memberships figure is due to the reclassification of the Brazilian societies to the Agricultural section. The Canadian figures refer to the Publishing Co-operatives affiliated to Conseil Canadien de la Cooperation. From the U.S.A. the data covers the National Rural Electric Co-operative Association, Group Health and the Co-operative League of Puerto Rico.

ASIA From a report submitted to our publications editor we learned of School Savings, Transport, and Mutual Benefit societies in Jordan and from the Statistical Schedule issued by the Department of Co-operative Development in Malaysia information was extracted referring to School societies. Transport and Taxi societies and General purpose societies.

The data reproduced in this table were received from 59 co-operative Insurance organisations in 20 countries.

The total number of policies is certainly understated as 15 of the 59 Insurance societies did not provide this information.

No comparative figures are given since the 1966 questionnaire was altered to make it more simple. The information now received is in accordance with that collected by the I.C.A. Insurance Committee, and we are indebted to that organisation for providing some of the data published in this report.

The total premiums received for 1966 were £579 million, an increase of 18.40 % over the £489 million received in 1965.

The total claims paid rose from £227 million in 1965 to £294 million in 1966, an increase of 29.51 %.

Soceidad Interamericana de Desarrollo de Financiamiento Cooperativo was recently admitted into membership of the I.C.A. Its headquarters are in Washington and its purpose is to offer technical assistance to already existing co-operative banks in Latin America and to promote new co-operative banks within that region.

The Co-operative Permanent Building Society of Great Britain is not included in these tables. Its purpose is to finance the acquisition of private dwelling houses. Its total assets are £447 million for 1966, a 14.03 % increase over the previous year. During 1966 it loaned to its members £88 million.

The percentage figures produced on the preceding two pages can be used only as a rough indication of the position of the world co-operative memberships figure in relation to population.

In Europe, some countries with large agricultural co-operatives include in their membership figures farmers who are members of more than one agricultural society. This will enhance the membership figures of that country thus overstating the percentage figure of the total population.

From Africa and Asia the data received are often very limited and the countries may well have a much better percentage of members in relation to population than our figures indicate.
