FOREWORD

Education and training for co-operative development is a process of passing on information about relevant co-operative knowledge and experience.

Sources of locally accumulated information are usually both known and available to the educators, and such information, based on local experience, is often the most relevant one.

Its limitation to the local context is, however, a weakness as well as a strength. Co-operative educators need a wider horizon; they cannot isolate themselves. There is a constant need for gaining more knowledge, comparing experiences and keeping up with the development. The more advanced the education and training tasks are, the more urgent is the need.

Valuable knowledge and experience have, indeed, been accumulated in many parts of the world over many years – and are continuously being accumulated. There is a wealth of information available, provided that the sources of it are known.

Co-operative training institutions in the developing countries, and the educators working within them, are very often not in the mainstream of the flow of information. It does not reach them automatically; they have to search for it, and they have to begin by trying to find the sources.


This handbook is intended as a guide in the search for information, a search which is not an end in itself, but a means of promotion of co-operative development.

Introduction

MIA

The aim of this handbook can be formulated in simple terms:

"To assist those in search of information about co-operatives to find some useful sources of such information."

It is primarily published in order to serve co-operative education and training institutions, but it is hoped that it will also prove useful to persons engaged in research on co-operatives, to librarians and information officers, etc., as well as to the 'practitioners' in movement or government service. By its nature it will be of assistance also to persons outside the co-operative movement, such as academic researchers and librarians.

It is a guide to the main sources of co-operative information in the English language. It does not aspire to be a complete reference book, but it will provide the user with basic information about sources, which, when necessary, might help to lead the search further on.

LANGUAGE

Except in the case of the worldwide list of co-operative contact points in the Appendix, the references in the handbook are to sources where English is the only or predominant language, or where a reasonable amount of information in English is available, irrespective of the actual language of the country concerned.

The assumption is that the reader of a handbook in English is also able to draw advantage from information in that language, and all the sources listed are therefore relevant from that particular point of view.

However, this assumption does by no means exclude the likelihood that many readers are also able to read information in other languages, or, indeed, that they would prefer another language.

We suggest therefore, that when you write to a certain source for information, you should state your own 'language capacity' or preference, so as not to limit yourself to the information which is available in English. It goes without saying that most of the information available at any one source would be in the language of the country concerned.

It is hoped that the English edition of the handbook will be followed by editions focused on sources in the French and Spanish areas.

STRUCTURE

The handbook is divided into six chapters, each giving comments and advice on a separate type of source of information. In each chapter there is a list of references to the most important - or for that category typical - sources.

In addition to these lists, which are restricted to sources where information

in English is available, there is an Appendix listing selected co-operative contact points in most countries of the world. Finally, there is an Index.

HOW TO FIND THE RELEVANT SOURCES?

When you need some specific information, perhaps for a specific purpose, the type of source is probably of less relevance to you. You are more likely to be looking for information about:-

- a particular <u>sector</u> of the co-operative movement (consumer, housing, credit etc).
- a particular geographical area (continent or country).
- a particular subject matter (education, research etc).

The Index will direct you to the most relevant sources. Look up the sector or the subject and you will find references to them. References are also given to the continents in the Index, but if you are interested in a particular country, you are advised to refer to the Appendix, and to the lists in the various chapters which are organised according to country. The speciality of the organisations listed in the Appendix is indicated. A study of the Appendix is therefore helpful also in a search for information on sector or subject.

When searching for some specific information, it is always useful to apply an imaginative approach, and consider what other related sources there could be, besides the most obvious ones. Look up associated subjects in the Index. Also remember that one source of information is likely to lead you on to another one. A successful search for information very often begins by identifying the points of further direction. This handbook is one such link in the chain, leading to the desired information.

CHAPTER 1

Reference Tools

1. Reference Tools

By reference tools is meant dictionaries, glossaries, bibliographies, publishers' catalogues, book reviews, directories and similar documents, i.e. listings of words and concepts, organisations, published works etc. They provide basic information, facts and background about sources of information - the foundations for further study. These reference tools are often available in libraries and co-operative colleges. Some are easy to obtain, such as catalogues, accessions lists and book reviews, and are generally available free of charge. Others - dictionaries and encyclopedias - can be quite expensive and are usually only available through booksellers.

Some current reference books on co-operatives are listed below. Under some headings we have listed all the available works, but under others e.g. bibliographies, we have had to make a selection, to include those of more general interest.

A. DICTIONARIES AND GLOSSARIES

Dictionaries and glossaries list and define terms and can also translate them into other languages.

These are the only two available in English, dealing with co-operative terminology.

LAMMING, A: A Co-operator's Dictionary, London, CEMAS, 1976

(Lists and defines approximately 500 co-operative terms).

WATKINS, W.P. Vocabulary of Co-operative Terms, & LAMMING, A: London, ICA, 1974.

(English, French, German, Spanish & Russian terms of frequent use in co-operative texts.)

It is, however, not uncommon that vocabularies of co-operative terms are published by national co-operative organisations to assist in translation from the relevant language to English, French, German, etc. (See list of organisations, Appendix)

Directories list organisations, institutions etc., with addresses and occasionally give a summary of their activities. Below a number of international co-operative directories are listed, National and other local directories exist in many countries, but have not been listed here for reasons of space. D. BOOK REVIEWS

Most periodicals listed in Chapter 4 include book reviews on recent books. Some periodicals, such as the ICA Review of International Co-operation and the Annals of Public and Co-operative Economy also list new books.

E. PUBLISHERS CATALOGUES

Few general publishers include books on co-operatives in their publishing programmes and therefore not many co-operative books will be found in their catalogues.

However, there are several co-operative organisations which fill this gap. Their lists provide a good overview of current co-operative books and pamphlets. See Chapter 2, section on acquisition of books.

CHAPTER 2

Books

2. Books

There are many books on co-operation published every year. They are brought out by a variety of bodies, such as national and international co-operative organisations, co-operative colleges, research institutes, universities and commercial publishers. A representative selection of such organisations is found below.

Books are available on most subjects. Some subjects are more widely covered than others, e.g. agricultural and consumer co-operation are well documented, whereas handbooks on co-operative insurance are much rarer.

Books should be used with discrimination. Some of the information they contain is out of date by the time they are published. This applies particularly to books which describe ongoing co-operative development in a given economic or geographical area. As basic background material they are invaluable. They provide permanent records of events, analyses of organisations and cover wide aspects of co-operative activities. However, up-to-date information can best be obtained from periodicals, annual and other reports, proceedings of meetings and direct contacts (personal or by letter) with organisations or persons.

Books and other sources of information often complement each other and therefore use should be made of both.

Handbooks are in many cases only useful for a limited period from the date of publication. Care should be taken always to use the latest edition. CEMAS (Co-operative Education Materials Advisory Service) can provide further information on availability of handbooks for training purposes.

When buying books, it is important to ensure that you have as much bibliographical information as possible. This will facilitate identification of the book by the supplier, and the source from which it should be ordered.

CHAPTER 3

Reports

3. Reports

A major and sometimes neglected source of information is the whole group of documents, that can be included under the common heading reports. There are many different kinds of them, from annual reports of co-operative societies to university research reports. Papers presented at meetings and conferences belong to this group, and so do reports of the proceedings at such events. Other examples are statistics, government reports, evaluation reports, research reports, academic theses, laws and other legislation, etc.

This group of publications is often overlooked as a source of information. They are sometimes difficult to obtain and not often advertised. They nevertheless contain material which could not be obtained anywhere else.

Annual reports and statistics are published by co-operative societies, departments and registrars, and by many other organisations. They can be obtained by writing and explaining what the reports are needed for.

If you are aware of specific meetings and conferences which have been held, you can often obtain a copy of the conference papers and of the proceedings from the organisers. This is usually one of the most up-to-date sources of information about current and planned activities. New trends in co-operative thinking and action are often first reflected in discussion at meetings; conference and seminar reports or minutes would mirror these trends.

Research reports, academic theses and papers can be difficult to obtain. It is also difficult to find out about their existence. The best way is to check in the "Research Register" published by the ICA and the Co-operative Research Institutes in Warsaw and Budapest. Reference to such studies is also made in some bibliographies, such as the CIRCOM "Journal of Rural Co-operation" and the annual accession list published as an offprint of the Plunkett Foundation "Yearbook of Agricultural Cooperation."

Legislation and model byelaws can be useful for comparative purposes, as can the rules of co-operative societies. These can be obtained by writing to the relevant government department (or printing office), or national organisation. (For addresses see the ICA's "Directory of Government Departments" and the list in the appendix, of ICA affiliated organisations). Laws are occasionally published in English in FAO's "Food and Agricultural Legislation", and in the ILO's "Social and Labour Bulletin".

In order to be able to make use of reports of different kinds the following can be consulted for information on where to find the reports:-

Periodicals:

These often report on conferences and

seminars, and have bibliographical sections

and reviews.

Bibliographies:

May list published reports, laws, research and academic reports (remembering that the material listed will not be very up-to-date except in the case of periodical bibliographies).

CHAPTER 4

Periodicals

4. Periodicals

Journals are one of the most important means of keeping abreast of developing fields of knowledge.

A. COVERAGE

All aspects of co-operative activity are covered in periodicals. Some specialise in one subject. Others specialise in one country and many are the house journals for one co-operative organisation. The coverage in co-operative journals ranges from local co-operative news (dealing with just a district or town) to academic research undertaken at universities and by national and international organisations.

Periodicals are issued by a great variety of bodies. These include local, regional, national and international co-operative organisations, ministries responsible for co-operative development, research organisations and international organisations. They come in many different formats, with very varying frequency.

Co-operative information is occasionally also published in non-cooperative periodicals. This information tends to be difficult to track down. Lists issued by the Ministry of Overseas Development Library and the Overseas Development Institute, London, and the Institute of Social Studies, The Hague, The Netherlands, are good sources of information on these articles. Articles on cooperative matters from non-cooperative periodicals can also be found in lists contained in the journal "Annals of Public and Cooperative Economy", the Research Register Bulletins and in FAO's journals "Land Reform" and "Land Settlement and Cooperatives".

B. AVAILABILITY

Periodicals and journals are often discarded after use. Libraries, however, tend to keep many of them for periods between one and five years. Some are kept permanently. In some colleges, libraries and other organisations cuttings are made from periodicals of articles which will be of lasting importance. These cuttings constitute an important information tool, provided a subject index is established for them.

If you want to find an article on a specific co-operative subject, the following international sources of information may be consulted.

- a. ICA Documentation Bulletin for S.E.Asia.
- b. Research Register of Studies on Co-operatives in Developing Countries Bulletin.

- c. Plunkett Foundation "Yearbook of Agricultural Co-operation".
- d. FAO Agricultural Co-operation Bibliography.

Further information may also be sought by writing to the ICA, ILO and FAO. For articles on a particular country, national co-operative colleges, research institutes, national co-operative organisations, or the Ministry dealing with co-operatives, should be approached.

C. ACQUISITION

In order to acquire periodicals it is usually best to write to the publisher or issuing body. Most periodicals are available through subscriptions. In some cases it is possible to organise and exchange of periodicals between two organisations; some organisations issue free periodicals as well.

This is a very selective list covering a few of the periodicals from various countries and international organisations. The list is by no means exhaustive. CHAPTER 5

Libraries

5. Libraries

The Library structures vary tremendously from country to country. There are public (municipal) libraries, private collections, libraries attached to colleges, research institutions and big companies. All universities maintain libraries, very often with good up-to-date specialised collections. Access may be restricted to the university community but, generally can be extended if you can show a need of using the facilities. In most countries there is a national library, which collects all books published in the country, and sometimes co-ordinates purchasing and loan activities for the library network of the country.

Private collections also exist in many places. College teachers, representatives and advisers from international organisations such as UNDP, FAO and ILO build up their own very specialised and personal collections, which may give ideas on where to seek further information and advice on books and publications on a personal basis.

Co-operative colleges, departments and national organisations often start libraries with handbooks on how to run societies, compile statistics, management questions, etc. Unless there is someone responsible for the library, the collection will probably be out-of-date, so such libraries may not always be the best source of reference.

In most industrialised countries co-operative organisations have set up reference libraries, mostly for commercial information. These libraries also have books on co-operative theory and practice, and descriptive and analytical material about co-operative development, particularly in their own country. Since the libraries are for reference only, they usually cannot lend books, but will provide information.

The ICA has at its headquarters a large reference library, covering co-operative developments worldwide over the past 100 years. The ICA Regional Office for S.E. Asia in New Delhi also has an extensive collection of books, periodicals and reports, covering mainly that region and the ICA Regional Office in Moshi has started a library and documentation service. All these libraries welcome visitors and inquiries, and can provide information on books, periodicals, reports, co-operative events and developments by letter.

Libraries of co-operative organisations in membership of the ICA (and academic co-operative libraries outside of the ICA) have formed a Working Party of Co-operative Librarians and Documentation Officers. This body meets every two years and issues a quarterly bulletin called "Libradoc". There are articles describing libraries, information on new co-operative publications, specialised bibliographies, a section on archives and museums, as well as technical articles on librarianship and

information work. It can be obtained by writing to the Librarian, who is also Secretary of the Working Party. The members come from a wide variety of co-operatives - national, regional, international - in various fields - consumer, agriculture, credit, housing, research. A series of handbooks on aspects of co-operative librarianship is under preparation.

FAO and ILO regional offices maintain libraries. These cover the latest literature in their areas, and constitute good sources of information. They are set up for the staff of their organisations, but could be used more widely, perhaps through a local FAO or ILO expert.

All libraries are pleased to have their resources used and to answer requests for information. Unfortunately, no libraries have facilities for extensive research; this can only be undertaken by the inquirer himself. Requests for information should be as precise as possible, giving the background and aims of the work, in order to enable library staff to give maximum co-operation.

The CEMAS resource centres, whilstnot maintaining libraries, are in a position to provide advice on handbooks, teaching literature and audio visual aids.

The list below is an indication of the type of organisations, institutions and colleges, where co-operative libraries are to be found. The ICA "Co-operative Education Directory" provides a comprehensive list of co-operative colleges around the world.

CHAPTER 6

Organisations

6. Organisations

In every country there is a large number of co-operatives, from small village societies to regional unions and national federations. Many other organisations provide services for co-operatives, such as co-operative colleges, libraries and research units. Outside the movement, bodies such as universities, government departments, technical assistance agencies and international organisations may also be of use to co-operators in providing information and advice.

There is, therefore, a range of sources of information - firstly the co-operatives themselves (at various levels), secondly co-operative educational and advisory bodies. Finally, a range of institutions dealing with co-operatives not as their prime function, but in an incidental manner or on an ad hoc basis.

Organisations and institutions arrange meetings, conferences, and courses and publish journals, books, pamphlets, and reports. In this chapter you will find references to a number of organisations which you may find useful as information sources. You will find the references to their publications in the appropriate chapters (books, periodicals etc). You should not hesitate to write, or to visit any of them. Few places will turn down your request for information if you can show your need for it.

Make your requests and queries as precise as possible. Write in simple, clear language and, if you visit an institution, get in touch by letter or phone beforehand. In addition to using institutions as information sources, it is important to build up a network of personal and informal contacts. These will help you to speed up replies and make it easier to obtain access to information.

The list which follows contains references to the main organisational sources of co-operative information. You will not find local, regional or national co-operatives there; these addresses have to be found in national or international directories. You could start by consulting the list of ICA member organisations (see Appendix), the "Directory of Co-operatives" and "Directory of Co-operatives in Africa South of the Sahara" published by the International Labour Organisation. The main co-operative libraries are listed in the chapter on libraries (see chapter 5).

In many countries there are ministries or departments responsible for co-operatives. Most of these are listed in the ICA Directory of Addresses of Government Ministries/Departments. Other ministries may also have information and/or responsibilities regarding co-operatives, for instance, ministries of agriculture, education, commerce, trade and industry.

In making a selection for the list which follows, we have included international organisations (both co-operative and non co-operative); some co-operative colleges and research centres, as well as some bodies which can be direct or indirect information sources, such as aid organisations.




